THE POSITION

The City of Saginaw staffs a full-time Fire Department. Firefighters fight fires, respond to hazardous material incidents, administer first aid, answer rescue calls, inspect buildings for fire hazards, maintain equipment and stations, and perform other such related work as required daily. Tours of duty are 24 hours each; average number of tours is 2.25 weekly with 54 hours of duty a week.

REQUIREMENTS

- Must be at least 18 years of age.
- High school graduate or GED equivalent.
- Firefighter I and Firefighter II certifications are preferred, but are not required.
- Must be a citizen of the United States.
- No felony convictions.
- Height must be in proportion to weight.
- Vision not less than 20/40 in one eye and 20/100 in the other eye, correctable to 20/20 in one eye and 20/40 in the other eye. Must not have color vision defect.
- Must be in good physical health, free from any impediment of the senses, and in possession of extremities.
- Must possess normal hearing.
- Must possess a valid Michigan Driver's license at time of hire and maintain one throughout employment.
- Must successfully complete a 12-month probationary period.

EXAMINATION

Applicants must successfully pass a written test and an oral interview. Study guides are provided to prepare for the written test. Final candidates must also successfully pass a physical agility test, a background investigation, and all phases of a pre-employment medical exam to include drug testing and a psychiatric exam.
