THE POSITION

This position performs standardized laboratory work within the City of Saginaw's Wastewater Treatment Plant under supervision of the Chief Chemist. Duties include routine laboratory tests, sewage system sampling, record keeping, maintenance and operation of laboratory equipment, industrial discharge and river sampling, and participation in plant operations.

REQUIREMENTS

- Associate's degree in Chemistry, Biochemistry, Biology, Engineering or a related field; or equivalent work experience; Bachelor's degree preferred
- State certification for wastewater treatment is desirable
- Must have hands-on work experience in a laboratory, testing samples against standards
- Ability to exercise independent judgement
- Ability to demonstrate leadership skills
- Must be computer literate; able to use technical programs upon completion of training
- Must be technologically oriented with ability to perform work using atomic absorption spectrophotometer, UV/visible spectrophotometer and related equipment
- Must be willing to work weekends on a rotating, scheduled basis
- Must possess and maintain a valid State of Michigan driver's license

EXAMINATION

Applications will be screened with qualified applicants being scheduled for a written test, a performance test and an oral interview. Candidates must achieve a score of 70% or better on each portion of the process to advance to the next phase of the selection process.
