THE POSITION

This is semi and limited skilled work in the City's 52 million gallon a day Water Treatment Plant responsible for operation and computerized control of plant and pumping station equipment. Duties include general maintenance and mechanical repair tasks; assumes lead worker responsibilities on assigned shifts or projects. Assists in operation of treatment functions as needed.

REQUIREMENTS

- High School diploma or GED equivalent
- Good mechanical aptitude with one year experience in the operation and maintenance of various types of mechanical equipment
- Basic knowledge of electricity, chemistry and biology
- Ability to read blueprints and electrical schematics is desirable
- State of Michigan water operator certification preferred. Must obtain and maintain F-4 certification within 2 years of placement into position and an F-3 certification within 5 years
- Must possess an understanding of computer systems; experience in computer-controlled plant equipment such as SCADA (Supervisory Control and Data Acquisition) preferred
- Able and willing to work a 24-hour/7 day a week work schedule. Scheduled shifts may require swinging to different shifts frequently, including weekends and holidays
- Must possess and maintain a valid Michigan driver's license.
- Able and willing to frequently lift up to 50 lbs., work in confined space, and work in a noisy environment requiring hearing protection under certain conditions
- Willing to work in a facility with several potentially dangerous water treatment chemicals
