THE POSITION

This is manual and semi-skilled work in the maintenance, repair and operation of plant/pumping station facilities and equipment in a wastewater and combined sewer environment. Duties involve varied maintenance and repair work of a general nature and operation of some plant machinery and equipment. May perform more skilled tasks under supervision.

REQUIREMENTS

- High School diploma or GED equivalent
- Prior experience in wastewater treatment plant maintenance preferred; or equivalent experience with chemical feed machines, pumps, boilers, grit removal equipment, etc.
- Knowledge/experience in performing manual and semi-skilled work in general maintenance and mechanical repair to include painting, window and roof repair, lubricating equipment, cement work and other general building and grounds keeping tasks
- Ability to cut metal with oxy/acetylene torch and weld with MIG and/or stick electrodes
- Ability to operate fork lifts, cranes and other special tools in the performance of duties
- Must be willing to learn computers and record keeping
- Ability to perform as lead worker on crews as assigned
- Willing and able to wear a respirator; occasionally work at various heights and depths; willing and able to work in confined spaces
- Must possess and maintain a valid Michigan driver's license

EXAMINATION

All applications will be screened; those best qualified will participate in the following selection process: Performance Test, and Oral Interview. You must successfully complete each component by 70% or better to proceed in the process.
