THE POSITION

This is semi-skilled work in the construction, installation, maintenance and repair of City water and sewer systems under general supervision. Work may include installing and repairing water and sewer mains and services as well as performing maintenance activities on utilities and providing water meter reading and servicing. This position may involve considerable contact with the public.

REQUIREMENTS

- High School diploma or GED equivalent
- Experience in performing manual labor tasks
- Knowledge of water and sewer systems, repair and construction standards
- Minimum two years' experience in maintenance and repair of water and sewer systems preferred
- Experience operating various types of construction and maintenance equipment
- Must possess a valid State of Michigan Class A Commercial Driver's License with N endorsement prior to date of hire
- Possession of a State of Michigan S-4 or higher Water Distribution License is desirable
- Ability to walk up to 10 -15 miles a day and read up to 500 meters as assigned
- Willingness to work outdoors in all types of weather and in adverse working conditions
- Willing to respond to an emergency situation 24 hours a day/7 days a week; able to respond within one hour of notification of an emergency

EXAMINATION

Applications will be screened. Those best qualified will participate in the following examination process: Written Test; Performance Test; Oral Interview. Candidates must successfully complete each component with a score of 70% or better to proceed in the selection process.
